Spears® produces a CPVC corrosive waste drainage piping system under the LabWaste® trade name. From the beginning, Spears® has adamantly insisted that installing contractors be adequately trained in the proper installation of these products and in new products developed. To that end, Spears® personnel have conducted thousands of classes for plumbing contractors across the country, and around the globe. Installers are issued training ID cards recognizing their participation and successful completion of these classes. Authorities Having Jurisdiction (AHJ's) have come to acknowledge the value of this training and frequently require that installers be able to verify their training by producing these cards on jobsites. Some manufacturers have taken a similar approach to Spears® and conducted suitable in-depth training classes; others have been less diligent.

Spears® continues to offer on-demand training to installers. Technical representatives are available to schedule training classes at contractors' shops, or other suitable facilities. A phone call or email to Spears®, or to one of our distributors, is all that's needed. A typical class will include a limited number of installers, often from a single company, and requires 2 to 3 hours to complete. Hands-on participation and testing are required for completion. While there are no recognized industry requirements, Spears® has always recommended refresher training every two years to review possible changes in codes, new products, methods, etc.
